**Determination of the applicable legislation on social security  
- Request pursuant to Art. 87 (8) of Regulation (EC) No. 883/04 -**

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you can see from the attached **"Certificate regarding the applicable legislation" (form E 101)**, according to Regulation (EEC) 1408/71 the legislation of ..... (name of country) applied to me on 30 April 2010 <sup>1</sup>. The relevant facts (kind and extent of activity) have since remained unchanged, so that, in principle, Regulation (EC) 883/2004 on the coordination of social security systems did not change the legislation on social security to be applied - due to the transitional provision contained in its article 87 (8).

Without the transitional provision, according to the information I have, the legislation of another Member State <sup>2</sup> would, in principle, apply to me from 01 May 2010 <sup>3</sup>. I would like to be subject to this legislation instead of remaining covered by the transitional provision.

As my place of residence (centre of vital interests) is located in Germany, you are responsible for determining the legislation on social security to be applied according to Regulation (EC) 883/2004. Therefore, I would ask you to determine the legislation to be applied to me on the basis of the information contained in the **attached questionnaire**. If German legislation applies to me, please issue the appropriate certificate for me.
